CMRT have obtained funding for a Data Projector that can be shared among Castlemaine's five (5) major cycling groups.

The direct beneficiaries of the shared data projector will be the five cycling groups in Mt Alexander - CMRT, Mt Alexander Cycling, Castlemaine Cycling, Cycling Safe Castlemaine, and Rocky Riders. More specifically, it will benefit their hundreds of members and the wider supporter bases which these groups comprise across the Shire. Ready access to a reliable data projector is needed by all these groups in order to make presentations to their members, supporters and potential sponsors from time-to-time. Their needs will amplify over the next 2-3 years as important council and government policy impacts cyclists locally.
